All scholarships are \$500 or \$1,000 unless otherwise indicated.

UNDERGRADUATES ONLY:

John C. Ale Scholarship—undergrads with preference to students at schools in South or Southwest and financial need.

Grace Bender Scholarship—for sophomores or above, financial need, 2.5/4.0 GPA.

Sonia Brown Memorial Scholarship--open to sophomores & above with demonstrated need & worth (academic average will also be considered).

David Coleman Scholarship—based on need with a “B” GPA with preference to California fratres who are sophomores & above.

Benjamin P. Goldman Scholarship—graduating seniors accepted to accredited law school, B average & show evidence of leadership & oratorical ability, financial need.

James R. Favor Scholarships—2 grants for Chapter Vice Prior or Risk Manager that has not had a risk violation in the past year with demonstrated risk mgmt. initiative and a 3.0 GPA.

Jack & Sara Freeman Scholarship—sophomores or above with B average or better and financial need.

Sidney H. Guller Scholarship--to a needy & worthy upperclassman.

Jimmy Hammerstein Scholarships--3 grants based on need with a GPA sufficient to lead to graduation, if maintained.

Joel Honigberg Scholarship—open to juniors & seniors in chemistry, physics, biochem., biogenetics, engineering physics or nuclear physics, astronomy or geology, 3.5/4.0 GPA.

Theodore J. Ignall Scholarship--available to a Liberal Arts senior with a “B” average who is going on to graduate school.

Nate Karchmer Scholarships--2 grants based on need, for juniors and seniors only.

Karchmer Family Scholarship--for undergrads based on financial need & Fraternity involvement.

Michael Karl Mem. Scholarship—sophs or above, financial need, acceptable GPA and commitment to chapter.

Manuel Leve Scholarship—for an undergraduate frater, sophomore or above, based on need and fraternity interest.

Margolis-Epps Scholarship—undergrads active in their chapter with C average and financial need.

Milken Family Scholarship--for sophomores & above planning a teaching career; “B” average required.

Martin & Howard Miller Scholarship--for sophomores or above with need, current or former chapter leader.

Paul A. Pumpian Scholarship--open to undergrads, based on need with a GPA of 3.0/4.0.

Leslie & Bobbie Raffel Scholarship—open to sophomores or above, engineering student in good academic standing.

James & Elsie Rasbold Scholarship—sophomores or above, engineering, science & mathematics major, academic achievement and chapter activity may be considered.

Ben Savage Scholarship--based on need and ΣAM interest.

Bill Schwartz Scholarships—3 grants for daughters of fratres (including those of deceased fratres) with need, at accredited 4-year institutions, also ΣAM alumni returned to school. Undergrads; soph or above.

Judy Schwartz Scholarship—sophomores or above, based on need and worth with academic average considered.

Marc P. Schwartz Scholarship—based on financial need and 3.0 minimum GPA in any major for any undergraduate.

Terry Semel Scholarship--to a needy former or present chapter officer with at least a “C” average.

September 11 Scholarship—based on worth and need for undergrads.

Martin Sherman Scholarship--to a needy and worthy sophomore or above with a “B” average.

Jerry Silver Mem. Scholarship—sophomores or above, leadership or outstanding participation in chapter or campus affairs, scholastic achievement and financial need.

Donald Stein Scholarship--for sophomores or juniors at Big Ten chapters with preference to sons of fratres with demonstrated need and a 2.25 GPA or better.

Deana & Gerald Stempler Scholarship—any major in good standing with university and Fraternity.

Preston Robert Tisch Scholarship--to a needy frater (not a freshman) with a “B” average.

Robert Traum Scholarship—sophomores or above with a C+ average or better with any major.

Weiss Brothers Scholarship—open to undergrad daughters of fratres with financial need & worth at a 4-year school.

UNDERGRADUATES OR GRAD

STUDENTS:

Warren & Esther Blumenfeld Humor Scholarship—to a student (frater or child or grandchild of fratres) for any original work of humor—written or otherwise.

Sam Fox Scholarship—open to an undergrad or grad student with need & worth, any major.

Gormin Family Scholarships—2 grants, soph or above, with need and GPA of 3.0/4.0 preparing for a career in law, medicine, dentistry, business or psychology.

Katch Family Scholarship—open to junior or senior undergrads or grad. Students, financial need 2.5/4.0 GPA & accounting major.

Albert Kauff Memorial Scholarship—open to students with need, preference to those with physical challenges, learning disabilities or other special needs, documentation required.

Robert Kauff Memorial Scholarship—open to students with need, preference to those with physical challenges, learning disabilities or other special needs, documentation required.

David D. Levinson Scholarship--open to soph or above, GPA of 2.75/4.0. Preference to those who are challenged or disabled in some way. Documentation required.

Ira N. Lind Business Administration Scholarship—open to a business major.

Hanno D. Mott Scholarship—for a law student or a senior intending to go to law school with a “C” average & involvement in Jewish service activities.

David S. Rice Scholarship—sophomores and above accounting majors with Jewish activity and involvement preferred with preference to Rho & Gamma Epsilon chapters.

Raymond & Helen Sandler Scholarship--based on need with “B” average required, for junior, senior or grad student.

Wallach Associates Inc. Scholarship—engineering, math, physics, operations research or computer science majors with a B average and financial need.

Harvey Weisblat Aviation Scholarship—for one academically studying aviation or demonstrably seeking an aviation career (flying, maintenance, flight operations, air traffic control or other aviation-related fields). (\$2,000)

Michael J. Weiss Memorial Scholarship—based on need with a 3.0 GPA or above for undergrad or grad student.

Seymour Weiss Engineering Scholarship—for junior or senior undergrads or grad students, minimum GPA of B, preference to majors in civil engineering, land surveying & mapping or environmental engineering.

GRAD STUDENTS ONLY:

Dr. Lewis A. Hare Scholarship--open to medical student fratres with need and good academic standing with preference to Eta chapter.

Allan E. Miller Scholarship—based on financial need to grad student in any academic field.

Samuel Miller Awards--3 grants to graduate student fratres for original research.

William Ober Scholarship—2 grants to graduate student fratres with need and a 3.5 GPA. (\$2,000 each)
